WebLab scientist was appointed deputy ambassador to promote science education!

Project scientist Dr. Sven Hille from the Leibniz Institute for Baltic Sea Research Warnemünde (IOW) was appointed deputy ambassador by the EU funded Scientix project for the academic year 2013-2014. Until September 2014 he will be part of a teacher's panel made up of 30 ambassadors and 60 deputy ambassadors from EU member states aiming to promote science education among pupils of their home countries.
